

## **Checklist & Tips for Writing a Great Obituary**

**Gather Information -** Start by collecting essential information.

☐ <b>Full Name</b> – Include any nicknames or preferred
names.
□ Date and Place of Birth - Specify the birthdate and
location.
□ Date and Place of Death - Mention the date and
location of the passing.
☐ <b>Family Details</b> – List surviving family members,
including spouse, children, grandchildren, and
siblings.
☐ Education and Career – Highlight their educational
achievements and career milestones.
☐ <b>Hobbies and Interests</b> – Include their passions,
hobbies, and interests.

□ Community Involvement – Mention any commun	ity
or volunteer work.	
□ <b>Notable Achievements –</b> Highlight significant	
accomplishments.	
☐ Service Details – Include information about funera	al,
memorial, or burial services.	

**Structure the Obituary -** Follow a clear structure to convey the information effectively.

- Opening Start with the full name, date of birth, and date of death.
- Biographical Information Provide a brief overview of their life, including education, career, and family.
- Achievements and Passions Highlight notable achievements, hobbies, and interests.
- Community Involvement Mention any volunteer work, organizations, or causes they were passionate about.
- Survivors List surviving family members, including spouse, children, and siblings.
- Service Information Include details about memorial services, funeral arrangements, and any requests.

## **Tips for Writing an Obituary**

### **Write with Sensitivity**

- Use a respectful and compassionate tone.
- Focus on positive aspects of the person's life.
- Avoid sharing controversial or overly personal details.

#### **Edit and Review**

- Proofread the obituary for accuracy and grammar.
- Ensure all details are correct, including service information.

#### **Include a Photo**

Consider including a recent photo of the deceased to personalize the obituary

## **Example of a Well-Written Obituary**
